

July 11, 2022 Monthly Meeting Minutes

- 1. MOU Revision and 2022/2023 Budget -2^{nd} round of comments in. One Shoreline (San Mateo) still to review. All agencies to be invoiced shortly.
- 2. Summer Flood Control Projects Round Robin
 - a. Zone 7 Santa Cruz: while the Stream Maintenance Program was in progress, the county was told to submit a WDR for a project. The process that ensued was protracted: multiple requests for more information.
 - b. Zone 7 Alameda County, has also received multiple requests for additional information that have held up permits/extended permitting time and costs. This has been discussed in the BAFPAA Environmental Permitting Committee. We should agendize it again and strategize as to how to get this to a higher level of management (perhaps new Water Board EO?).
 - c. Vallejo is trying to install an in-channel trash capture device. This installation has also required a Regional Board permit. Mitigation has been tricky: there have been back and forth regarding homeless encampments and mitigation ratios. What has emerged is discrepancies in guidance from Water Board management and line staff.
- 3. BAFPAA Website is being updated with a new logo. Members should check the site and ensure that their agency's logo and links are current.
- 4. CHARG The steering committee met again this month to discuss progress on white papers and the budget.
- 5. AQPI X-Band Radar not installed yet at Rocky Ridge. Contra Costa working on the internet.
