- 1. Luisa Valiela on 2024 SF Bay Program Priorities
  - a. 2022 Authorization requires annual priority list
  - b. \$54 million in competitive funds for 2023, in future not competitive grants
  - c. Looking for comments and questions on list, will change in the future
  - d. Comments
    - i. How will you determine WQ improvements of multibenefit projects? This has not yet been determined but it will be a part of funding. Not intended to be infrastructure program (more than just flood benefits)
    - ii. For natural infrastructure, what about erosion prevention? What is large? The program will not be for small projects, Large and Multi-benefit still not entirely clear. How money will be moved has not been determined.
    - iii. Has a standard application been developed? Not yet. Probably next year.
    - iv. Need to involve stormwater agencies
    - v. Urban green stormwater is hard to understand
    - vi. Would like to find out about Pajaro funding
